HOLY WEEK at GOVANS

Palm Sunday - April 2: Join us for at 10:00 a.m. this very special first Sunday combined service. We will do a procession of the Palms to begin the service. In place of the sermon the choir will be performing "Dark Night Of the Soul", by Norwegian composer, Ola Gjeilo, and two choral pieces by African American composer, B.E. Boykin (with one of them being a world premiere!).

Maundy Thursday - April 6: Join us in the Sanctuary for a Maundy Thursday Communion Service followed by a performance of a seat-gripping musical tale of the crucifixion composed by the French Impressionist composer, Olivier Messiaen. This big organ work will serve as accompaniment to members of our Biblical Storytelling Team who will perform a dramatic pantomime of the Last Supper and Garden of Gethsemane.

Good Friday - April 7: Please join us for a ecumenical Good Friday Service hosted at Unity Fellowship in Towson (120 Allegheny Ave., Towson, MD 21204) at 7:00 p.m. We will be joining several other local churches in a traditional Seven Last Words of Jesus service. We will have 7 pastors (including Pastor Tom) from 5 churches preach on the 7 last sayings of Jesus from a social justice perspective. Those who wish to carpool can meet at Govans in the big back parking lot. Carpools will leave at 6:30pm sharp!

Alston, Foster Parent recruiter from the Kennedy Krieger Institute will visit us to discuss their Foster Care program for special needs children: The Therapeutic Foster Care Program at Kennedy Krieger offers a variety of services for children with special needs who require temporary or permanent out-of-home placement. We match children and teens with families who can offer them stability, love and attention until they can be returned to their families, adopted or transitioned to independent living. We are looking for either full time Foster Parents or Respite Care Providers who can be a relief for parents for a day or a weekend. We will hear about their kids, and the specialized training and support that KKI provides foster parents. The discussion will take place in Sharp Hall and on Zoom.
