Request for Proposals

Govans Presbyterian Church - Art for Sanctuary

Deadline for Proposals: March 11, 2024

Budget & Timeline: We have a total budget of \$5,000. We will select the artist by April 6, 2024 and would like the project delivered no later than the end of July 2024.

Project: Commission a Black Baltimore artist to create and display two pieces of art in our sanctuary to provide racially diverse images in our worship space that is currently Eurocentric.

Objectives:

- Create images of people of color in our worship space to communicate that all are welcome and children of God.
- Have something visual for people to meditate on during church services, offering a
 narrative, story, or way of being that is different from the Eurocentric imagery currently in
 the church.
- Challenge members to a more expansive view of God and people.
- Bring a contemporary element into the sanctuary.
- Incorporate artwork that is reflective of worship or community.

The two pieces will be hung at the front of the sanctuary on either side of an existing stained glass window. The artwork can be in any 2D medium (abstract, mixed media, fabric, banners, paintings, digital) and must be able to be hung on the walls. The works would ideally work together as a diptych - see the geometry shown in the attached diagram. 2D media may include low relief.

Budget & Timeline:

We have a total budget of \$5,000. We will select the artist by **March 25** and would like the project delivered no later than the end of June.

Proposals Should Include:

- Initial sketch of the design or photo if already created
- Material to be used with description of colors
- Suggested placement on the wall
- Dimensions
- Information about the artist including background
- Artist website or images of other work

Selected Artist should be prepared to:

- Attend a Racial Justice Committee meeting to hear more about our vision for this work.
- Attend a Sunday worship service, and hold a listening session for the congregation following the service.






